

Education Station Interpreter Requirements

Job description

Education Station interpreters will work in the Whose Home area both with the public and behind the scenes. These volunteers will complete the required training needed to understand the needs of young children and how young children learn through play. Interpreters will be required to work in Education Station at specified times, providing general topic and themed interpretation presentations, as well as roaming interpretation.

Number of adult/teen volunteers Interpreters needed

Unlimited

Time commitment

- Must commit to 8 hours a week during the summer months
- Cannot miss more than 6 scheduled times.

Required training

Education Station Interpreters must complete Education Station Interpretation Training and General Interpretive Training. Whose Home interpreters will be required to know basic information about the Whose Home exhibit and construct an information packet/booklet which will be used as a resource. The packet will be reviewed by the Teen Team Leads prior to being accepted as a resource.

Minimum age 14 years old
